



# DUKE UNIVERSITY EAST CAMPUS

## TRAVEL

Getting to and from Duke is easy. Just eighteen miles from the Raleigh-Durham International Airport, the university is located near the intersection of two major interstates—Interstate 40 and Interstate 85. As you leave Duke:

### To get to I-85 North (to Virginia):

From the traffic circle, take Chapel Drive to Duke University Road; turn right. At the traffic light, turn right onto Cameron Blvd. (NC 751). At the fourth traffic light, turn left onto US 15-501 North; this will merge with I-85 North.

### To get to I-85 South and I-40 West (to Winston-Salem and Charlotte):

From the traffic circle, take Campus Drive (beside Undergraduate Admissions) to Swift Avenue; turn left. Take the Durham Freeway (NC 147 North) until it merges with I-85 South. Follow I-85 South until it merges with I-40 West. Then, as the two interstates split outside Greensboro, I-40 will take you toward Winston-Salem, and I-85 will take you toward Charlotte.

### To get to I-40 East (to airport and Raleigh):

From the traffic circle, take Campus Drive (beside Undergraduate Admissions) to Swift Avenue; turn left. Take the Durham Freeway (NC 147 South) until it merges with I-40 East.

### To get to 15-501 South (to Chapel Hill):

From the traffic circle, take Chapel Drive to Duke University Road; turn right. At the traffic light, turn right onto Cameron Blvd. (NC 751). At the fourth traffic light, turn left onto US 15-501 South. Follow the signs to Chapel Hill.
